

WAS YOUR RESIDENCE **UNINHABITABLE** FROM HURRICANE IAN OR HURRICANE NICOLE?

You can apply for a tax refund for 2022, if your residence was deemed uninhabitable for at least 30 days or more.



DEADLINE:
APRIL 3, 2023

Individuals applying should bring the following documents for proof of uninhabitability:

- Utility Bill
- Contractor's Statement
- Insurance Information
- Building Permit Application
- Building Inspection Certificate of Occupancy

To qualify for the 2022 tax refund, you must provide supporting documentation showing your residence was uninhabitable for 30 days or more.

Contact your local property appraiser's office for more information or to request an application. If submitting an application ***IN PERSON***, an appointment ***MUST*** be made and copies of your supporting documents must be taken.
